

Mabel Creek Fish Passage and Habitat Development

This project will improve habitat and passage targeting resident coastal cutthroat trout populations above natural anadromous fish barriers in the Young's River watershed. This project focuses on restoration of passage via removing 3/4 mile of floodplain road, placing 300 pieces of large wood, and removing or upgrading six road crossings that restrict fish movements, stream hydraulics and bedload transport.

Objectives:

- Remove 300 feet of road remove or upgrade 6 road crossings
